

Seymour Lake Cemetery Prices and Ground Regulations

The Cemetery is owned by Charter Township of Brandon. All activity is monitored by the Clerks' Office.

Price Information:

Single grave site, payable within one year.
If not paid, ownership will return to Brandon Township without refund. Price is **\$400.00 for each grave.**

Price for Brandon Township residents is \$400.00 for each lot.

Price for non-residents is \$600.00 for each lot.

Contact Genesee Valley Vault for prices for openings, closings and foundation costs at 810-695-5166.

Note: Two internments per gravesite are allowed. One burial and one cremation burial or two cremation burials. **All opening, closing and foundation prices are set by Genesee Valley Vault Service. All prices are subject to change.**

There will be no burial or stones set on a gravesite until purchase of the lot is complete. All gravestone foundations shall be installed by Genesee Valley Vault Service, unless other arrangements are made with the Clerk's office. All prices and rules are subject to change by the Township Board without notice.

Liability:

Brandon Township holds no liability against theft or damage. Anything stolen or damaged may be covered by the grave owners homeowner's insurance policy. The cemetery holds no liability for plants or trees that may be damaged when digging a grave or during standard maintenance.

Care of Graves:

Planting will be allowed on the East side of the monument. Flowers may be real or artificial. Landscaping with stones and/or fences is **NOT** permitted. Trees or shrubs shall be approved by the Clerks' Office before planting. Any shrub, tree or broken, damaged urns and vases or items that are unsightly to the cemetery may be removed or trimmed by Brandon Township.

Spring clean up will be on or about the 15th of April each year. **Fall** clean up will be on or around November 1st. Anything you wish to save must be removed by that date.

No person shall leave refuse on the grounds.

No person shall break, destroy or deface any tree, shrubs or other property of the cemetery or it's members.

No person shall cause any damage while driving on the grounds. Any violations will be required to pay for the damage and/or prosecuted under the provisions of Michigan Law.

Sashabaw Road is on the West side of the Cemetery

One foot at West side of grave is for placement of headstone.

Plantings may be placed on the East side of the headstone.

Approximate Grave size is 3 foot X 9 Foot, including headstone space.

Lots run North to South, graves run East to West with head placement at the West end. Grave 1 is to the North, grave 8 is to the South. All graves are to be at ground level.
