

Brandon Township Parks & Recreation 3 vs 3 Basketball Tournament Rules

1. Only registered players on the team roster may participate.
2. Coed teams must play in the male division.
3. Team grade division is decided by the highest grade out of any player on the team.
4. The 1st/2nd grade divisions will play on 8-foot basketball rims. The 3rd-10th grade divisions will play on 10-foot basketball rims.
5. A 28.5 size basketball will be used in all 1st -8th grade divisions as well as the female 9th/10th grade division. The 9th/10th male/coed division will use an official basketball (size 29.5).
6. No jewelry allowed on persons during play.
7. Fighting is automatic ejection from the tournament with no refund of the registration fee.
8. The court monitor has the right to stop the game if coaches or fans are out of control. A forfeit may occur if necessary.
9. The team listed first on the schedule will be considered the home team.
10. A flip of the coin determines who gets the ball first. Games are 20 minutes with running clock or the first team to score 15 points. Championship games are 20 minutes with running clock or the first team to score 20 points.
11. Only one time-out per team per game.
12. Must throw in ball at all dead ball situations (start of game, after a made basket, out of bounds, after any call made on the court).
13. Substitutions may only occur on a dead ball situation.
14. One point per score, and two points beyond the arch.
15. Call your own fouls and court monitor can change the call if needed. Five team fouls results in free throw shot. If missed, the shooting team gets the ball out of bounds. If the shot is a made, defense team takes the ball out of bounds. The shooting team can shoot for two, then the ball goes to the defense team after the shot.
16. A technical foul (called by court monitor) will result in an automatic two points for opposite team.
17. Two technical fouls by the same team will result in loss of the game.
18. If overtime takes place, whichever team scores first gets the win. A flip of the coin will determine who gets the ball first.
