**-Sat. meeting locations-**All volunteers will meet at Edna Burton Sr. Center by 8:30 a.m. on April 25th to pick up supplies and job site information.

**-Workers must provide-**rakes, shovels, garden tools, gloves & water bottles.

**-Job Description-**rake and bag leaves, pick up branches and sticks, clean out flower beds. Each worksite will have a list of what they need done and you will cover up to 1/2 acre and spend no more than 30-45 minutes tops at each worksite.

**-Work Hours-**the work day begins at 9 a.m. and will be done by 3-4:00 p.m. or until all jobs are completed. (Call Faye Bindig at 586-292-2768 when your jobs are completed.)
